## ATV:

### **ATV Safety – Off the Road Again**

- 29 minutes, Adult / All ages
- Mississippi Farm Bureau / 1992

### **A Trip Unplanned – An ATV Safety Story**

-18 minute DVD

### **Ride Safe Ride Smart**

- 8 minutes, All ages (family together)
- Discusses important safety aspects of ATV riding (training course, safety equipment, respect for environment, etc.)

### **Gearing Up for ATV Safety**

- 23 minutes, Older kids / teens / adults (age 14 & up or so)
- Reviews safety equipment, how to check your ATV, conservation, and very good examples of driving course instructions & examples.

## Auto / Driving:

### **Danger Behind The Wheel: The Facts About Distracted Driving**

25 minute DVD. Grades 7 – Young Adult

This DVD emphasizes the dangers of driving distractions – applying makeup, eating, cell phone use, changing radio channels, but most of all, texting while driving.

### **DUI – The Hard Truth**

29 minute DVD – Tells the stories of four car crashes as a result of Driving Under the Influence of alcohol.

### **Gimme the Keys Please**

16 minutes, Teens / Parents of teen drivers

Same as “Beginning Drivers – The High Risk Years” video

### **In the Blink of an Eye**

- 12:50 minutes, For all Drivers
- Safety for slow moving vehicles. Directed at person's driving regular vehicles who encounter slow moving vehicles.

### **In The Company of Trucks – Be Seen, Be Alive!**

Discusses several things the driving public should be aware of as they share the roads and highways with big trucks. The main points are that trucks need more time and distance to stop than regular passenger vehicles, there are blind spots behind, in front of and on either side of trucks where the truck driver can not see another vehicle and other tips on how to reduce the likelihood of causing, or being involved in, a crash with a big truck.

10 Minute DVD from NC Association of Professional Loggers

### **Beginning Drivers – The High Risk Years**

This video listens to 16 year olds tell why they want their driver's license and what driving means to them. Parents of teenagers who died in crashes tell how the tragedies happened and how their families have been affected. Discusses young driver's inexperience, poor judgment and peer pressure.

## **First Aid:**

### **CPR – The New Basic Procedure**

- 22 minutes, Adult
- Instructional / demonstration of CPR theory & application

### **F.A.R.M.E. - First Aid for Rural Medical Emergencies**

160 page Instructor's Guide to First Aid and Injury Prevention for Farm Families.

Includes DVD.

The F.A.R.M.E. training manual addresses basic steps in accessing emergency medical services, stabilizing the scene of accidents, delivering first aid, and considering risk factors for preventing injury or illness among farm and rural residents. The manual is designed for use by instructors of first aid who wish to target their instruction toward individuals and their family members engaged in farm and farm-related activities.

Manual includes 11 chapters with quiz at end of each chapter, set of 14 case studies, and an Exam with Answer Key.

### **First Aid Farm Quest (DVD)**

## **Farm Equipment:**

### **A Tractor Accident Can Happen to Anyone (VHS and DVD)**

- o 17:15 minutes, Adult
- o Tractor safety emphasizing Rollover Protective Structures (ROPS) and seatbelts. Examples of risky situations and personal testimonials.

### **A Close Call (VHS and DVD)**

- o 8:30 minutes, Adult
- o Farm Machinery Safety, different examples of close calls with different types of machinery. Points out spear points, crush points, and wrap points.

### **Electric Pallet Jack (Spanish version) (OSHA Safety Video)**

Examines proper safety procedures for operating and maintaining powered pallet jacks. Topics include operator safety rules, daily maintenance procedures and general safety procedures when operating this equipment. Also used to train manual pallet jack operators. (12 minutes)

### **Farm Tractor Safety, More Than Plows and PTOs. (DVD).**

Divided into 9 Chapters (approximately 6 minutes each).

53 minutes total run time.

- Variety of persons discussing electrical accidents & safety points.

### **Farm Safety Family Style**

- 13:43 minutes, Adult
- Three families talk about the importance of developing "safety attitudes" for all family members, especially children, on the farm.

### **North American Guidelines for Children's Agricultural Tasks**

- 5 minutes, Adult
- Promotes using the guidelines to help determine appropriate agricultural tasks for children & youth
- (Does not contain much safety information, mostly promotional)

### **Grain Bin Safety, Protecting Yourself and Your Family**

This DVD contains both a long version which is about 13 minutes, and a short version (which leaves out some of the material) which is about 6 ½ minutes in length.

This is an excellent video sponsored by the National Corn Growers Association and The National Grain and Feed Foundation.

### **Pesticide Safety for NC**

- SPANISH
- 53 minutes, Adult
- Discusses Pesticide safety, handling pesticides, and green tobacco sickness.

### **Safety on the Farm**

- 26 minutes, Adults
- Discusses different safety aspects including ATV's on the farm, towing, shop safety, handling chemicals, power tools, tractor safety, fire extinguishers, and testimonials of injured persons.

- 11 minutes, Adult
- National Safety Council video on how to make your home safe including kitchens, stairways, kids rooms, baths, and around the house.

- Safe & proper methods for approaching, haltering, leading, tying, & general handling of horses.

## **Personal Safety:**

### **It Can Happen to You**

- 28 minutes, Adult
- How to prevent personal violent crimes at home, in auto, & on street. What to do if attacked.

## Water:

### **Boating Safety**

- 59 minutes, Adults
- In-depth coverage of many aspects of boating safety including basic boat & navigational information, safety points, operating guidelines, navigation, legal requirements, and emergency situations.
- Older video. Good content, but some "wear and tear" to video .

## Youth:

### **Every Time Every Ride**

- 22 minutes, Kids / teens (age 8 & up) (Adults ok too)
- Horse Riding safety emphasizing use of helmets. Testimonials of kids/teens/adults who had accidents or know people who had accidents. Shows how helmets are tested and has doctors talk about injuries.

- 6 minutes

### **Right from the Start –**

#### **Safety Awareness for the Next Generation of Livestock Producers.**

Targets youth handlers and families with practical livestock handling safety information. Excellent for 4-H and FFA members with livestock projects. 12 Chapters including Introduction, Safety Basics, Cattle Trailers, Horse Trailers and 8 species specific chapters. Chapters are 2 to 20 minutes in length. This DVD was produced by the Southwest Center for Agricultural Health, Injury Prevention and Education at the University of Texas.

### **Visiting a Farm? "Be Safe and Sound" Says Safety Hound (DVD)**
